Overview of Marine Corps Support

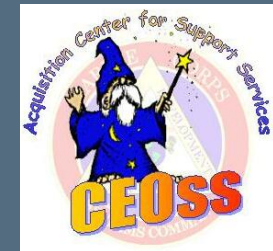
Overview of DoD and Federal Agency Support
